Bristol Temple Meads	3.5 miles	London, South, South Wales, South west, Midlands, North
Bristol Parkway	3.6 miles	London, South, South Wales, South west, Midlands, North
Filton Abbeywood	2.6 miles	Bath, Portsmouth, Cardiff, South West.
Sea Mills	1.7 miles	Bristol Temple Meads.
Redland	1.9 miles	Bristol Temple Meads.

Filton Abbeywood, Sea Mills and Redland stations often used as feeder stations for Bristol Temple Meads, avoiding the centre.

Destination	Via	Notes
Centre	N4 via Reedley Road , Hollybush lane and Downs	Includes Bridal path and cycle track
Centre	Henleaze, Redland Green, Hampton Road	Pleasant though Redland Green
Centre	Portway cycle track	Further, but flat, fast and off road
Cribbs Causeway	Henbury Road and joining N4	Mostly off road to the Mall.
Filton	Lake Road, Southmead	Light traffic, some cycle track
UWE, MOD abbey wood, Parkway	Horfield, Lockleaze	Light traffic, lots of cycle track. Quicker than by car in the rush hour.
Avonmouth port and industrial estates	Several routes, via Shirehampton, Lawrence Weston or Henbury	Foot / cycle only links. Good lights needed when dark.
